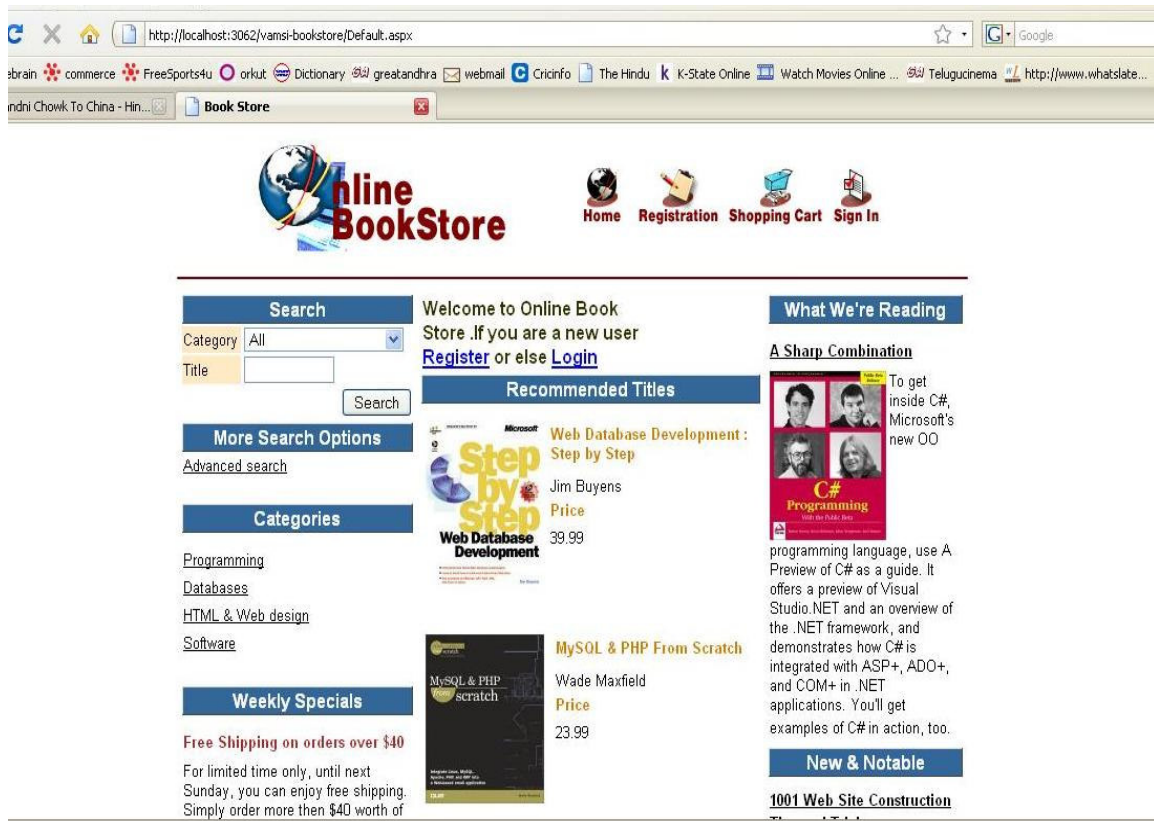

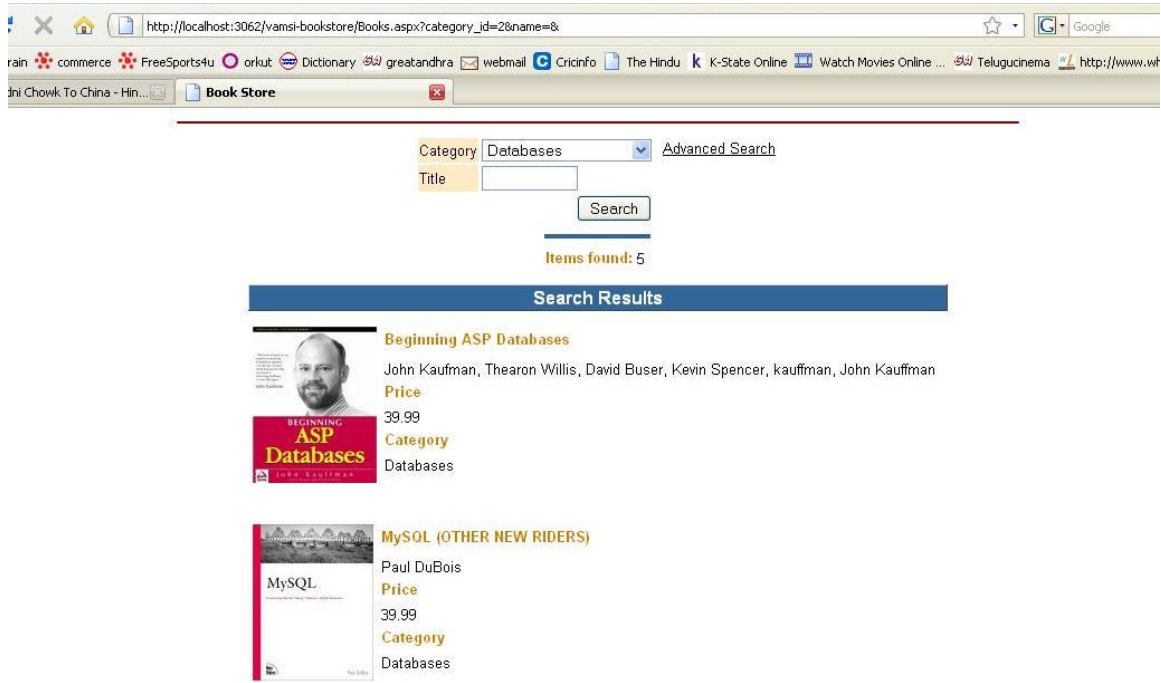

To search for a book the user can use the search and Advanced search options.



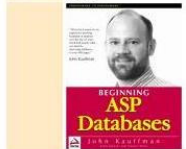
The user can search for a book based on price range, book title, author and Category. This option is provided in the advanced search page.

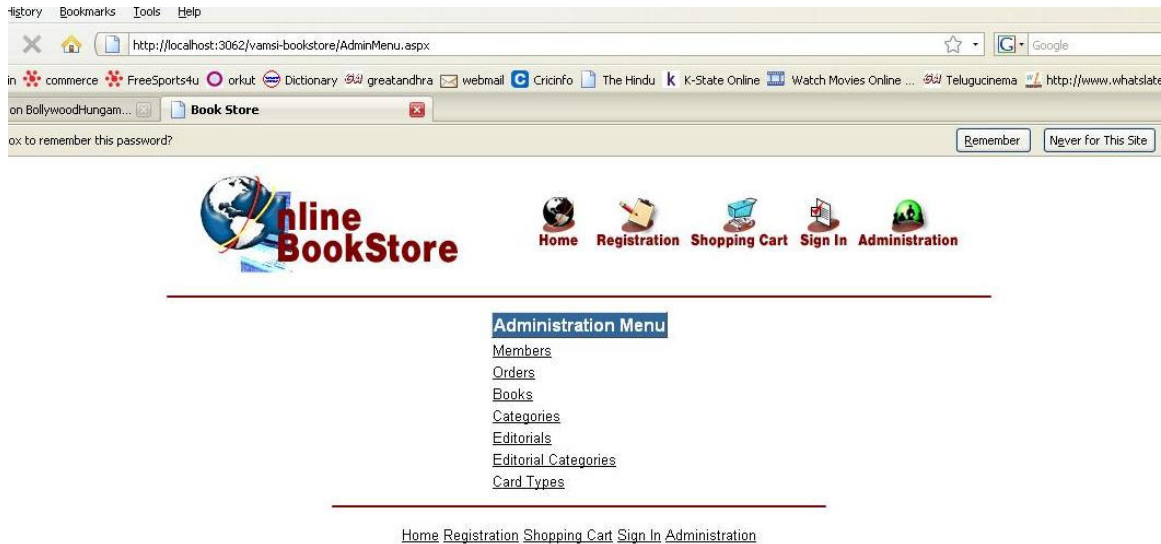
